BUCHAREST

Bucharest is a charming city with magnificent buildings, wide boulevards and lots of stories waiting to be discovered by the people who want to know just a little more about Romania's largest city and capital.

If you want to find out more about the city, here are some interesting facts about Bucharest that you may not have heard of.







The Palace of the Parliament

There's a good reason why everyone wants to see this building when traveling to Bucharest! Also named the House of the People, The Palace of the Parliament is the heaviest building in the world and the second largest and most expensive administrative building, right after the Pentagon. The Palace was ordered by Nicolae Ceauşescu, the dictator of Communist Romania, and it houses the Parliament of Romania along with three museums and an international conference center. If you want to find out how much it weights and other interesting facts about it, we suggest visiting this place.

Little Paris

Bucharest earned the nickname "Little Paris" in the period between the two World Wars because of the beautiful architecture built at that time. Little Paris also has its own Arc de Triomphe built after Romania gained its independence in 1878 so that the victorious troops could march under it. Inspired by the famous Arc de Triomphe in Paris, this Arc is a little smaller than the one in Paris

The Romanian Athenaeumis a concert hall in the center of Bucharest, Romania and a landmark of the Romanian capital city.

Opened in 1888, the ornate, domed, circular building is the city's main concert hall and home of the "George Enescu" Philharmonic and of the George Enescu annual international music festival. but still impressive and worth the visit. The Unirii Boulevard was also ordered to be like the Champs-Elysées, only bigger.

LOCATION

Otopeni is a town in <u>Ilfov County</u>, <u>Muntenia</u>, <u>Romania</u>, 10 km north of <u>Bucharest</u> along the <u>DN1</u> road to <u>Ploiești</u>.

Henri Coandă International Airport is located inside Otopeni.

HISTORY

The oldest discovered human settlements in the region are very old. On the occasion of excavations in 1966 to expand the nearby Henri Coanda International Airport, archaeologist Margaret Constantiniu of the History Museum of Bucharest identified fragments of ancient pottery and other objects that belonged to an important human settlement existing since the first period of the Iron Age. In an overlay was discovered another settlement are dated to the 10th century.

By charter of 14 February 1587, Mihnea Turcitu - voivode of Romanian - gave Holy Trinity Monastery half to the village of Islazul and half to the village of Hodopeni (today Otopeni) mills and gypsies.

On 20 May 1620, Maria, great Baneasa, Holy Trinity monastery was given back (later Radu Voda) half the village Hodopeni with Rumani, given by Master Villa, commanding Ruman listen. Historian Giurăscu Constantin believes that Hodopeni name of the village, comes from an Hodopa or Hodoba.

At the end of the 19th century, Otopeni town was part of Dâmbovița County, Ilfov Province, consisting of two villages, Otopeni Lower and Otopeni Upper, with 851 inhabitants in total. The commune operated a school with 29 students and two churches (one in each village). The village chambers were then part of town Bucoveni, with 125 inhabitants.

Otopeni was transformed into a city as part of Nicolae Ceauşescu's Systematization plan. It replaced the semidetached houses with four-story high apartment buildings.

Arrivals and Transportation

The Organizing Committee will facilitate airport welcome and transportation services upon input of the correct travel information no later than 17th June.

The Organizing Committee will welcome all members of the participating Federations at Bucharest "Henri Coandă" Airport (OTP), and/or Bucharest North Railway Station.

The Organizing Committee will be providing transportation services between the airport, the official team hotels, and the competition venue as per LEN COVID-19 Guidelines and Regulations; so, upon arrival, and also for departures, during all transfers, all must wear a face mask. Transportation schedules will be provided upon arrival.

No other transportation will be allowed.

COVID-19 Protocol:

At this moment there are no restrictions in Romania, and no special protocols are required for entry in Romania or for sport events.

However the LEN Sanitary Guideline shall apply.

If the situation will change, we will provide necessary updates.

Training and Competition

During the training and competition period, transport (bus service) between the pool and the official hotels will be organized for the event. It's mandatory to take ONLY the buses of the Organizing Committee and not public transports or others.

Passport Check: The Head of Delegation must present the passport of each team member before collecting the accreditation cards. The data on accreditation card will be compared to the data on valid passports of all participants and staff members.

Awards: Medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places in all events. Certificates will be distributed to the finalists in each discipline.

Floorplan – Competition pools, will be published in the next information bulletin.

DOPING CONTROL

During the Championship the doping control may be conducted. Any competitor participating Championship may be required to be tested for doping control.

INSURANCE

The Insurance of the participants is the responsibility of the respective federations. Insurance is also valid in the case of a Covid-19 infection.
